1 Competition Rules 競技規則について

This competition shall be conducted in accordance with the latest version of the World Athletics Competition Rules, Technical Rules and Regulations.

- 2 Registration for Local Participants 競技者受付について
- (1) Registration desk is located outside the Gate4 closed to 100m Start.
- (2) Kits Distribution Hours at the Stadium are as below.

♦31st May(SAT) 11:00~16:00 ♦1st June(SUN) 7:30~9:30

\*Overseas Participants who stay at the village hotel will receive the Kits at the hotel.

(2) Running direction at the Back Straight : Reverse Direction only

(3) Lane Allocation at the Indoor Warm Up Area is as below. Please follow the instruction of Officials.

◆Hurdles: Lane2&3、◆Run: Lane4&5、◆walk back: Lane1&6

(4) Personal Equipment is NOT permitted to be used at the Warm Up.

### 4 Roll Call 招集について

- (1) Call Room is located as below
  - a GP Events, Para Athletes, Highschool Events: Beside 100m Start at FOP (closed to the Water Jump)
  - b Kids Events : Outside the Athletes Entrance Gate
- (2) Roll Call Closing Time of all Events : 20 minutes before the Start
- (3) Roll Call Procedure
  - a Participating athletes must report at the Call Room within the Report Time. Hip numbers will be distributed at the Call Room.
  - b Delayed Report cannot be accepted, thus recognized as DNS.
  - c In case of withdrawal, a Withdrawal Form must be submitted at the Call Room.
  - d Athletes Bibs must be worn on both front and back as the size is distributed.
- 5 Competition Format 競技方法(要項から転載)
- (1) For GP races and non GP races, Round1 session will be conducted. Qualifying Conditions are as below.

A Final : 3 heats 2+2 from GP races

B Final : by time(rank 9th – 16th) of losers who are not qualified for A Final and all non GP R1 finishers C Final : by time(rank17th to 24th) of losers who are not qualified for A Final and all non GP R1 finishers If any athletes cannot run the Final race, they must inform the organizer within 20min. after the R1 race

(2) Based on the latest version of the Entry List updated on 30th May 2025 which is the closing date of Withdrawal Form Submission, Start List of Round1 races will be published at 17:00 on 31st May 2025.

- 6 Seeding and Tie for Ranking Position 競技の抽選及び番組編成について(レーン順)
- $(\,1\,)\,$  Lane assignments and are made by the organizer.
- (2) In case of a Tie for the last qualifying position, the following procedure shall be applied.  $\vdash$ 
  - a If there are lanes available, the tying athlete(s) can proceed to the next round.
  - b If there are NO lanes available, the actual time recorded to .001 second shall be considered for determination of the ranking. In case any athletes are still in a tie, lots shall be drawn to determine the higher ranking position.

### 7 Award Presentation

For GP Events, immediate after the Final Race finish, award will be presented at the site.

### 8 Other Issues その他

- (1) On the competition day, AD Control is operated at the stadium.
- (2) Gate Open : 31<sup>st</sup> May(SAT) 11:30, 1<sup>st</sup> June(SUN) 7:00
- (3) Trainer(Physio) Station is located at the main stadium on the competition day. It is available for GP participating athletes.
- (4) Waiting Room for GP Participants and Para Athletes is located on the first floor of the main stand as indicated in the stadium map.
- (5) After the finish of 100m, 110mH,100mH, participants are requested to return to the Start area to collect their track suit following the guidance made by Technical Officials.
- (6) First Aid is available in case of injury or any other accident. Further treatments are own responsibility.
- (7) Video Streaming of the Competition will be made through internet.

(8) Results will not be posted and not delivered by paper basis. They can be checked through the official web-site.

# 9 Doping Control ドピングコントロールについて

Doping Control shall be conducted under the World Athletics Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations and/or the Japan Anti-Doping Agency Code. In the pre or post in-competition Test, urine and/or blood samples may be collected.

Athletes designated for testing shall follow the instructions of the Doping Control Officer and be subject to Testing. Athletes designated for Testing shall present a photo identification, such as student ID with photo, driver's license, or a clearly visible passport copy.

Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE) Athletes with illnesses or conditions that require medication or undergo procedures as per the World Anti-Doping Agency's (WADA) Prohibited List, shall apply and acquire for a TUE in advance, through the Athletics Integrity Unit (AIU) or your National Anti-Doping Agency.
